This letter is to inform you that we have openings for the New Administrator Coaching Program. If you have new principals, assistant principals, or other administrators for this school year, you may recommend them for coaching by using the form below. Support for this program is through the Regional Office of Education for Will County with matching financial support made available by the Regional Superintendent the Honorable Shawn Walsh.

The ROE/Professional Development Alliance, as an approved certified coaching entity, can provide your district with a premier new administrator coaching program that can be customized to meet the needs of the district and your new administrators in the Launching Phase (Years 1-4) or Aspiring Phase (assistant principals preparing for the principalship).

Benefits of choosing the Will County ROE/PDA program are:

- Outstanding one-on-one mentors who have exemplary building leadership experience, as well as strong professional development skills in coaching and “best practices”
- Customizing the coaching program to meet your district and new administrator needs
- Ongoing quality professional development for mentors/new administrators
- Coaching opportunities provided on-site and off-site
- Networking opportunities provided for mentors/new administrators

The program will provide support for new administrators as they work to accomplish their professional growth (PERA) goals and student growth targets as set by their district and evaluator. Forty hours of personal coaching support will be provided to each new administrator. In addition, administrators in the program will have the opportunity to meet four times with mentors and other beginning administrators for peer-to-peer sharing and networking. Those completing the 40 hours of coaching will receive a \$100 voucher to use on any Administrator Academy Workshop here at the PDA. The cost to the district will be \$1,500 per administrator. Second year participants can choose the traditional 40-hour coaching program at the same cost (\$1,500 per district and \$1,500 from the Regional Superintendent or a 20-hour coaching program (\$500 per district and \$750 from the Regional Superintendent).
