





July 25, 2019: Every Student Succeeds Act Update: 8:00am - 10:00am

One elementary school district (designated as Underperforming during 2018-2019) will provide a progress report and share their experience. Participants will review the 5 Essentials Survey and hear how one school incorporates the survey results into their school improvement plan. As an approved Illinois Empower Provider, we will be sharing resources to help schools begin analyzing data and the planning process. At the end of this session, the group will identify hot topics for the next meeting.

October 16, 2019: 7:30am - 9:30am

We will review communication, assessment timelines and the planning process using the Illinois Quality Framework (IQF). Each participant will share their school's progress and select hot topics for the following session.

November 13, 2019: 7:30am - 9:30am

Participants will review timelines and deadlines and provide an update on their school's progress in completing the needs assessment, the IQF, and the work plan for school improvement. At the end of this session, the group will identify hot topics for the next meeting.
